- 4) New Business
- a) Operations

AES wants us to work the same as last year, with masks, gloves, face shields, bagging lunches. New this year is the allowance of volunteers to come in. Kitchen staff happy to have volunteers again. There will be a select few to start. Max 5 people a day (including kitchen staff). Monday $\frac{2}{3}$ volunteers, 2 for the rest of the days of the week. There will be 2 lunch hours/day vs 3 last year. No extra children allowed to accompany volunteers.

b) Costs

Groceries have gone up, packaging has gone up, therefore there will be a price increase on all items by at least \$0.25/item with the exception of milk, as this price was raised at the end of the

20/21 school year. Pricing will also go up for bananas and apples to help offset costs of the higher priced fruits offered on the menu.

We will continue to supply the office with food. Examples include, apples, bananas, cheese sticks, granola bars. Oatmeal will continue to NOT be supplied.

We will supply the office with ~\$50 worth of food each month. Helene will be asked to remind teachers that this is available for kids who have forgotten their lunch, etc.

We will continue to offer kids in need a credit every month. We previously offered \$50/month however was raised to \$75/month for the 20/21 school year. We will wait for the school to approach us with families in need. All credits will be placed in the family's account monthly and any items ordered totalled over that amount will need to be paid for by the order close date. Any unpaid balance will result in items being removed to reduce the total owed to zero. Families in need will be sent rules.

Money was raised via parent donation last year to help support families in need. Should we have an add-on option every month for donations? Potentially a round up option? Ady will check on the limitations of our order site.
